



Whether you have to transport your pesticides from the seller to the farm or around the farm, follow our top tips to keep you and your family safe:

- If using a vehicle, make sure it is in good condition and safe to transport pesticides.
- Transport pesticides separately from passengers, food and animal feed. Either by placing them in a separate compartment, or by using nets and boxes.
- The compartment should be dry, clean and free from any sharp objects that could pierce the container.
- 4. Secure containers during transport to prevent them from shifting.

- Avoid exposing packaging to excessive heat, rain, cold and other climatic extremes during transportation.
- Whenever handling the packaging always wear the minimum recommended PPE (long-sleeved shirts, long trousers, impermeable gloves and shoes).
- In case of an accident, clean up spills of chemicals in or around the vehicle immediately. If unsafe to do so, call the appropriate authorities.

Always comply with local laws and regulations of transport pesticides in your country/state.

Always transport in original containers away from foodstuffs, animals and people.
